VINEYARD

Ninety-nine year old vines from the Ross family vineyard's original plantings in 1912 in the Southern foothills of South Australia's Barossa Valley made this 100% Grenache wine. These gnarled old vines give consistent low yielding fruit with concentrated and complex flavors.

VINTAGE

2011 saw a cooler and wetter march and april than usual causing slow ripening and lower sugar concentrations previous years. This allowed for lower level alcohols and more delicate and elegant wines closer in resemblance to old world wines.

WINEMAKING

This Grenache was basket pressed and aged 17 months in new and seasoned French oak and emerged in a gorgeous crimson color.

TASTING NOTES

This delicious and complex wine boasts flavors of raspberries, cherries, sweet spices and musk with soft and silky tannins. Pair with chicken and pork dishes, or barbeque.
